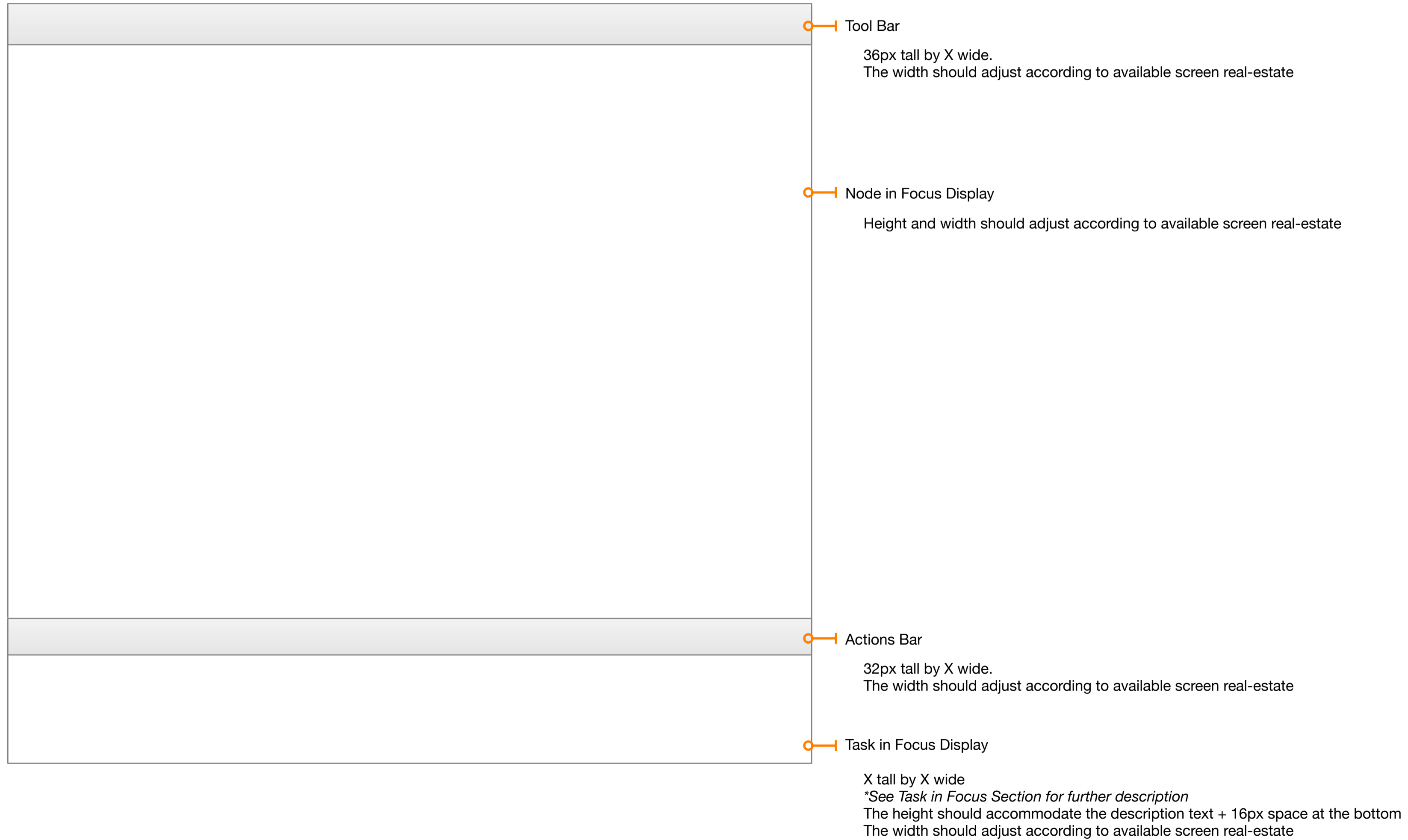

## Task In Focus - Construction & Click Targets

### MAXIMIZED TASK

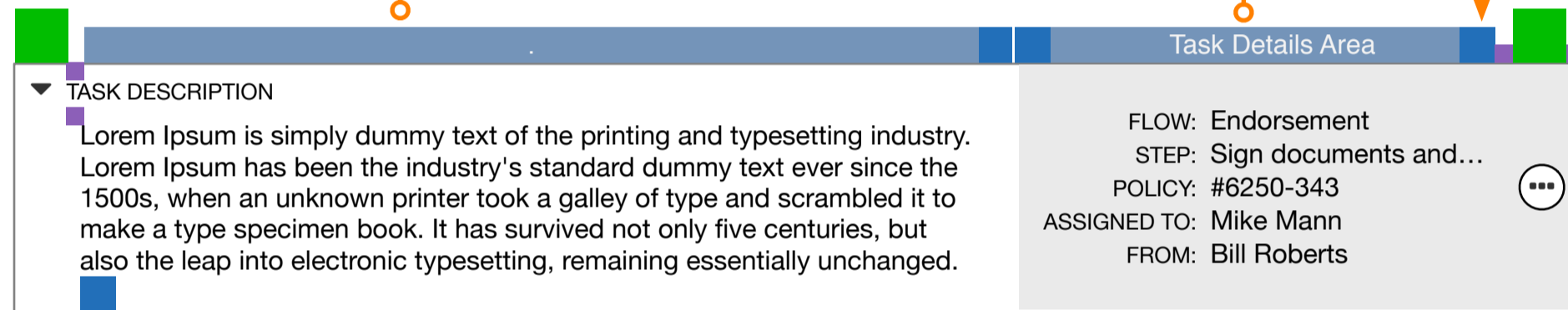
Task Description gets 65% of available screen width or whatever % is remaining after Task Details are displayed

Task Details occupy a minimum of 25% of the available screen width & max out at 35% of available screen width. The width can vary between those percentages as needed  
*See Example A*

Ellipse area (if needed)  
When an ellipse is used a tooltip should be available to display any truncated text

Task in Focus's height is determined by the height needed to display the entire description or details without scrolling plus 16px padding at the base

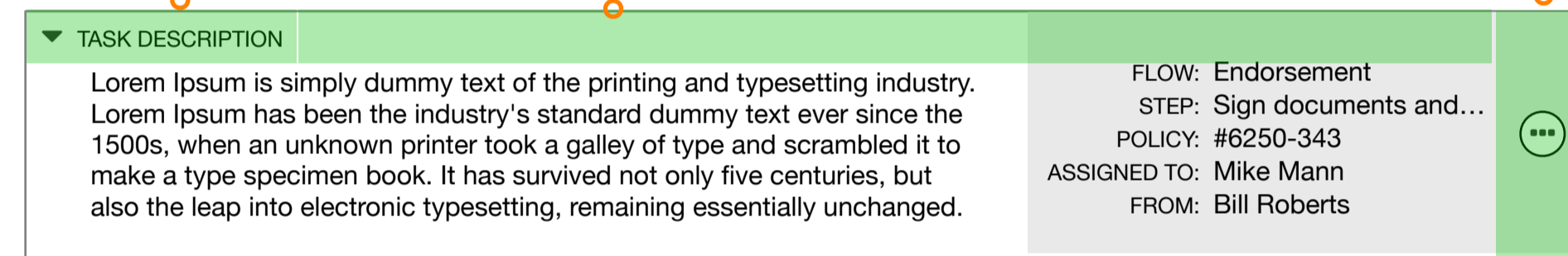


### MAXIMIZED TASK - Click Targets

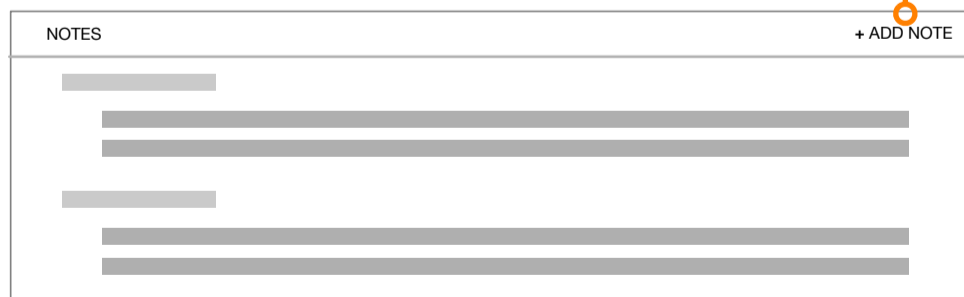

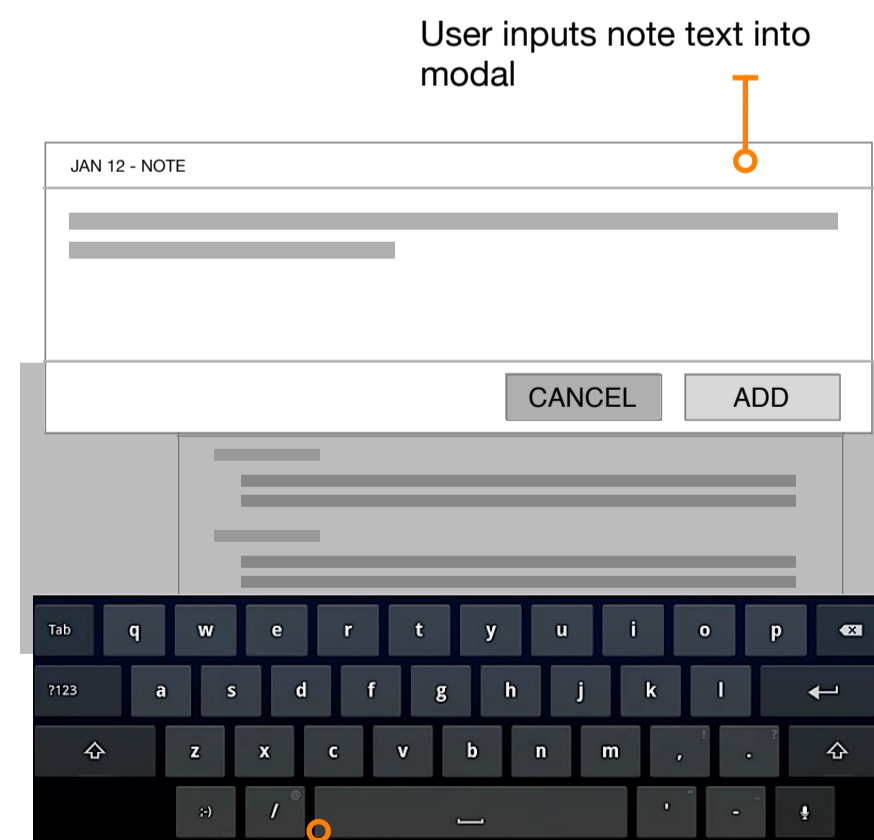

## Document Node Presentation & Manipulation

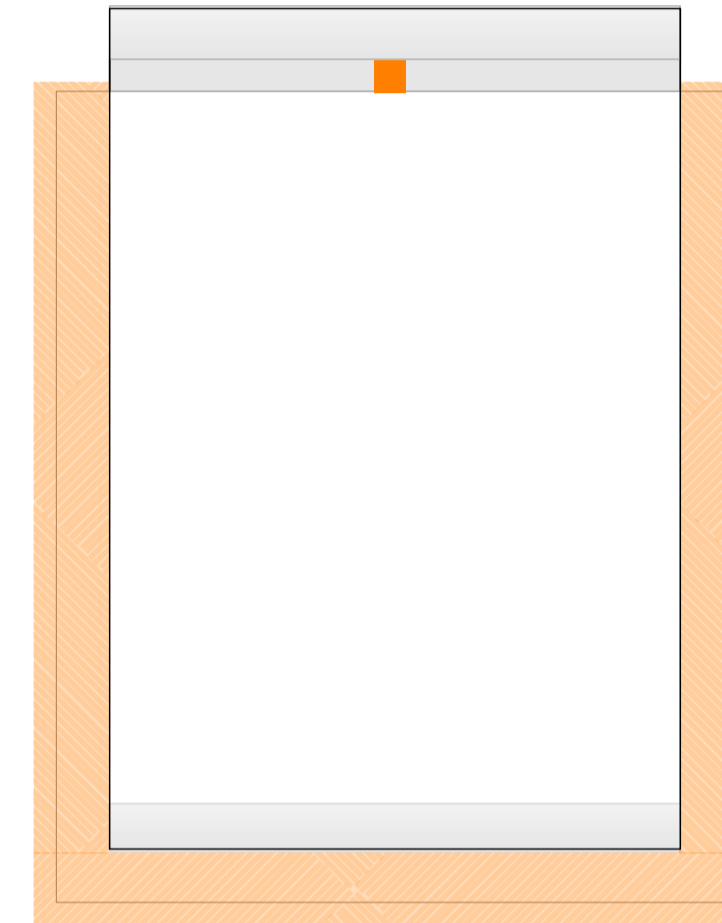
Upon entering a document, the image should be presented at 100% of the available width. The document can scroll under the toolbar but initially is positioned with a 24px padding between the top of the document and the tool bar. If possible include a 24px padding on the right and left of the document. The user can scroll, drag, or use directional keys to view the rest of the document.

The goal being to show as much of the document at a readable size as possible initially vs showing more of a thumbnail version that is unreadable.



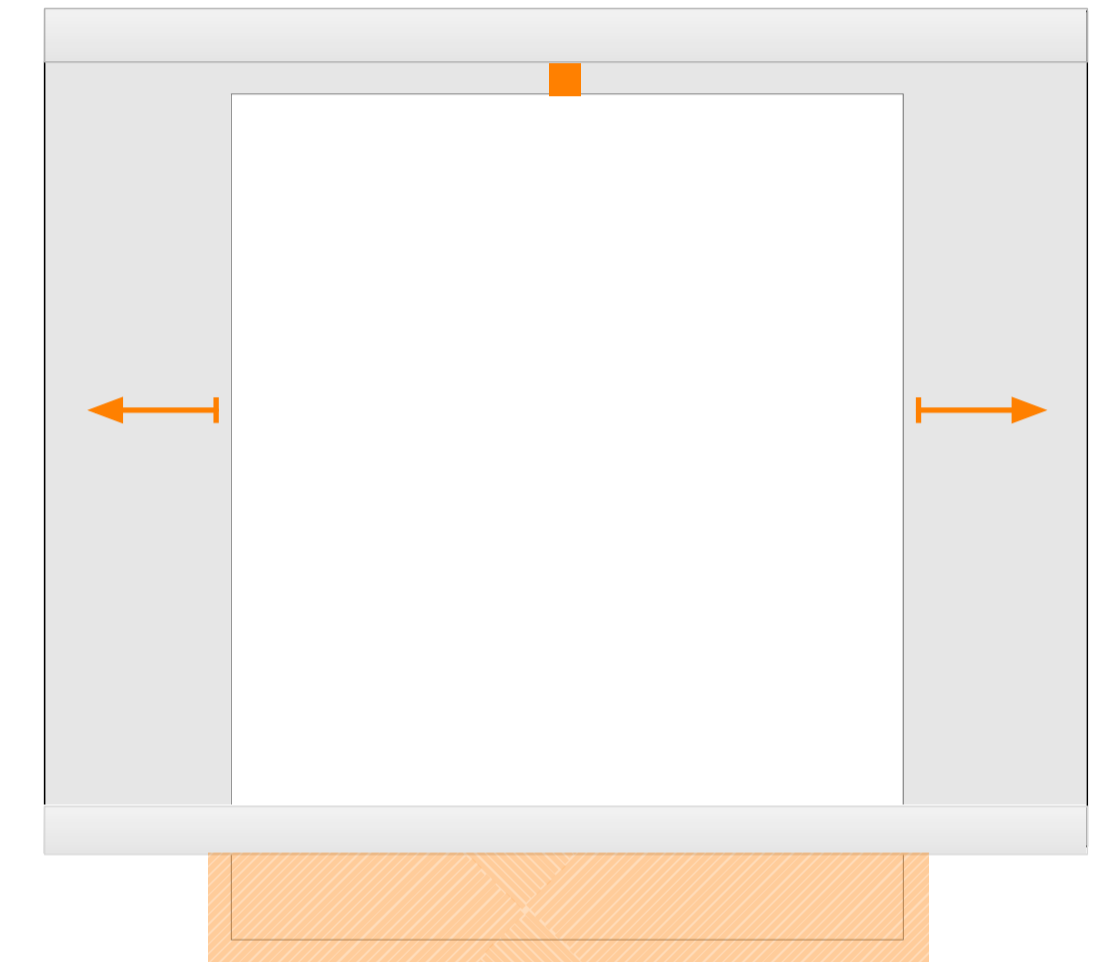

Very Narrow Width



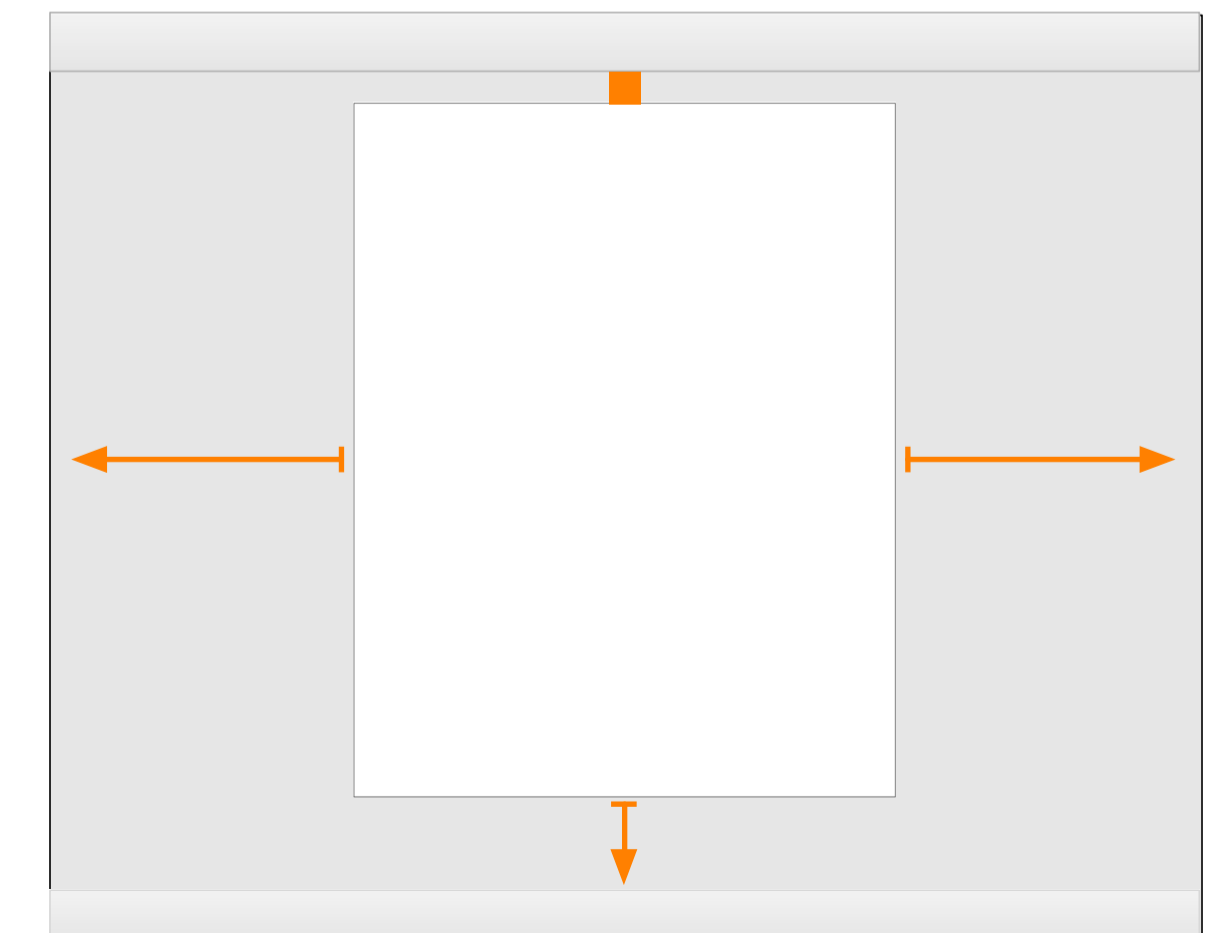

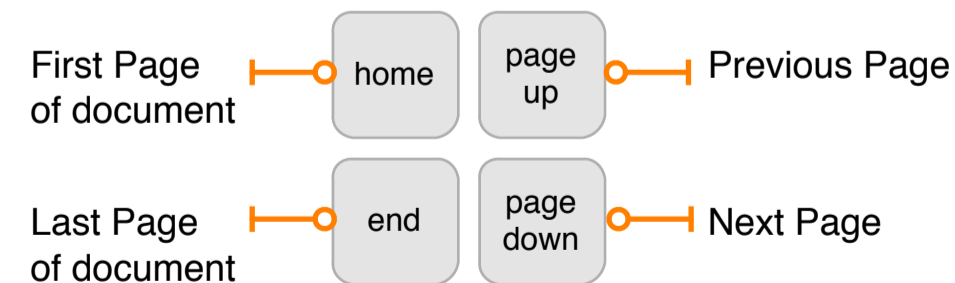
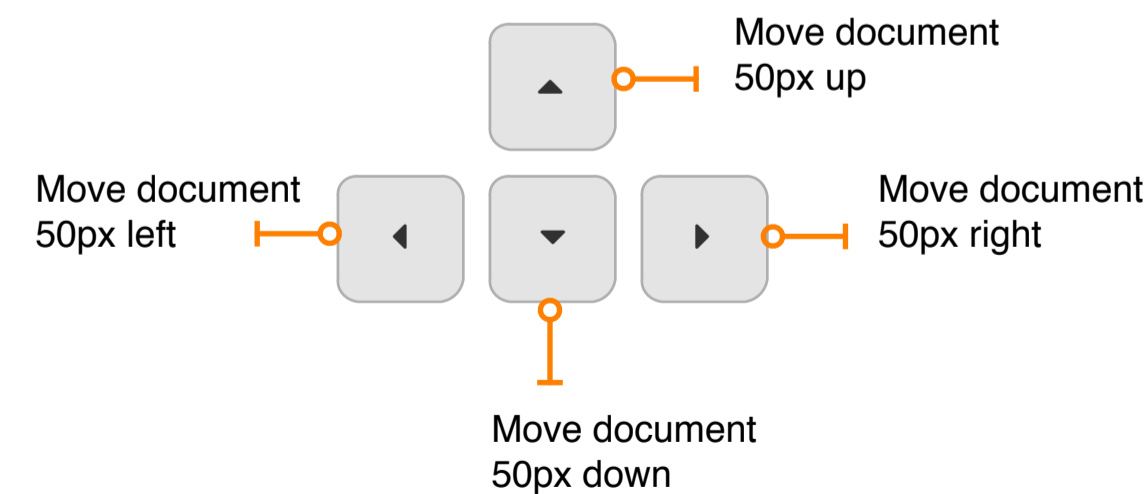

### TOUCH GESTURES

Pinch = Zoom Out

Spread = Zoom In

Double Tap = Reset Zoom to 100%

Touch and Drag = Move document in direction of the drag

Swipe Left = Next Page

Two Finger Swipe Left = Last Page of Document

Swipe Right = Previous Page

Two Finger Swipe Right = First Page of Document

Multi-Touch Rotate Clockwise = Scroll Pages of Document Forward  
 of 999

Multi-Touch Rotate Counter Clockwise = Scroll Pages of Document Backward  
 of 999



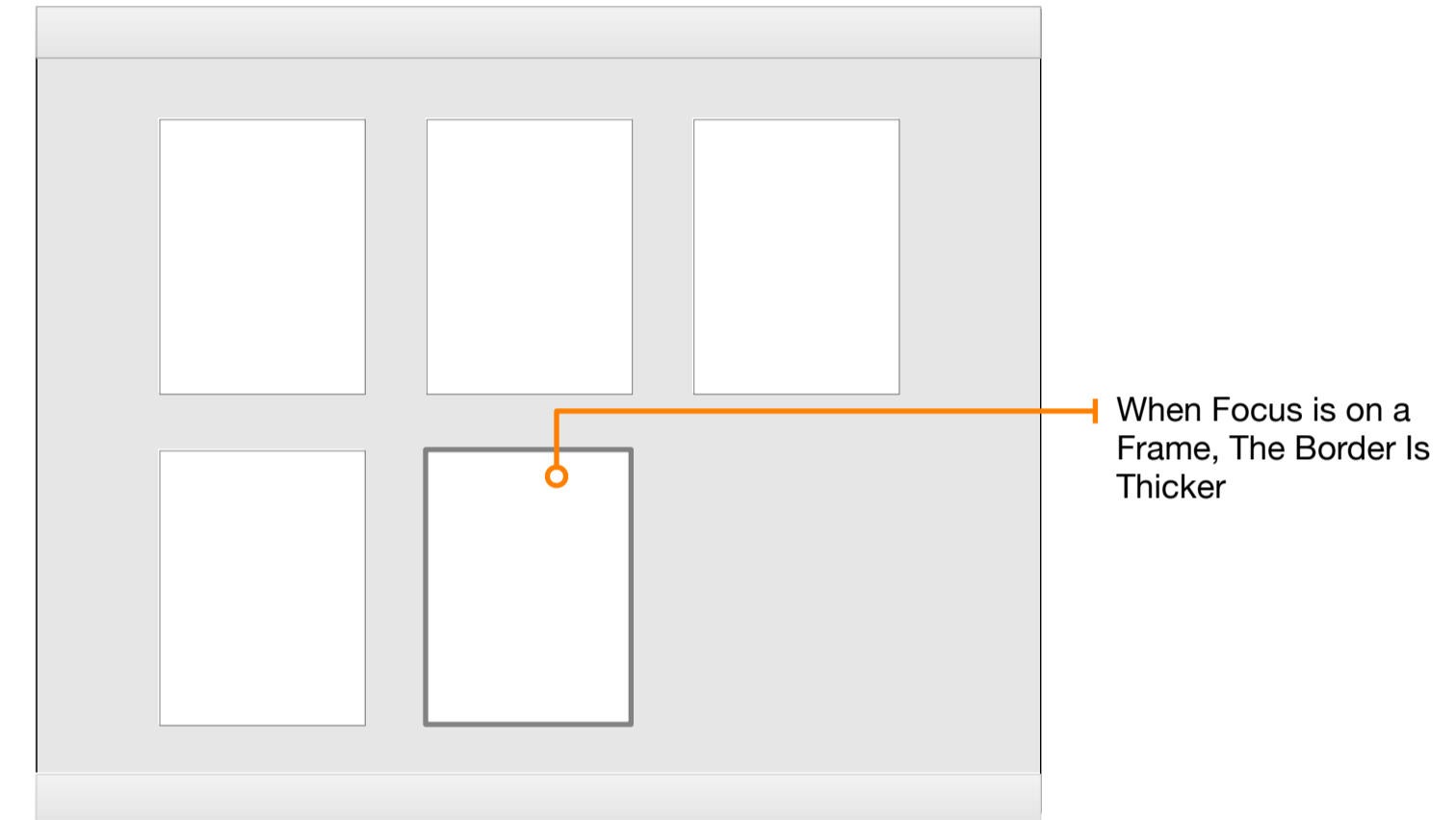

Jump To Frame Input changes when user selects the thumbnail

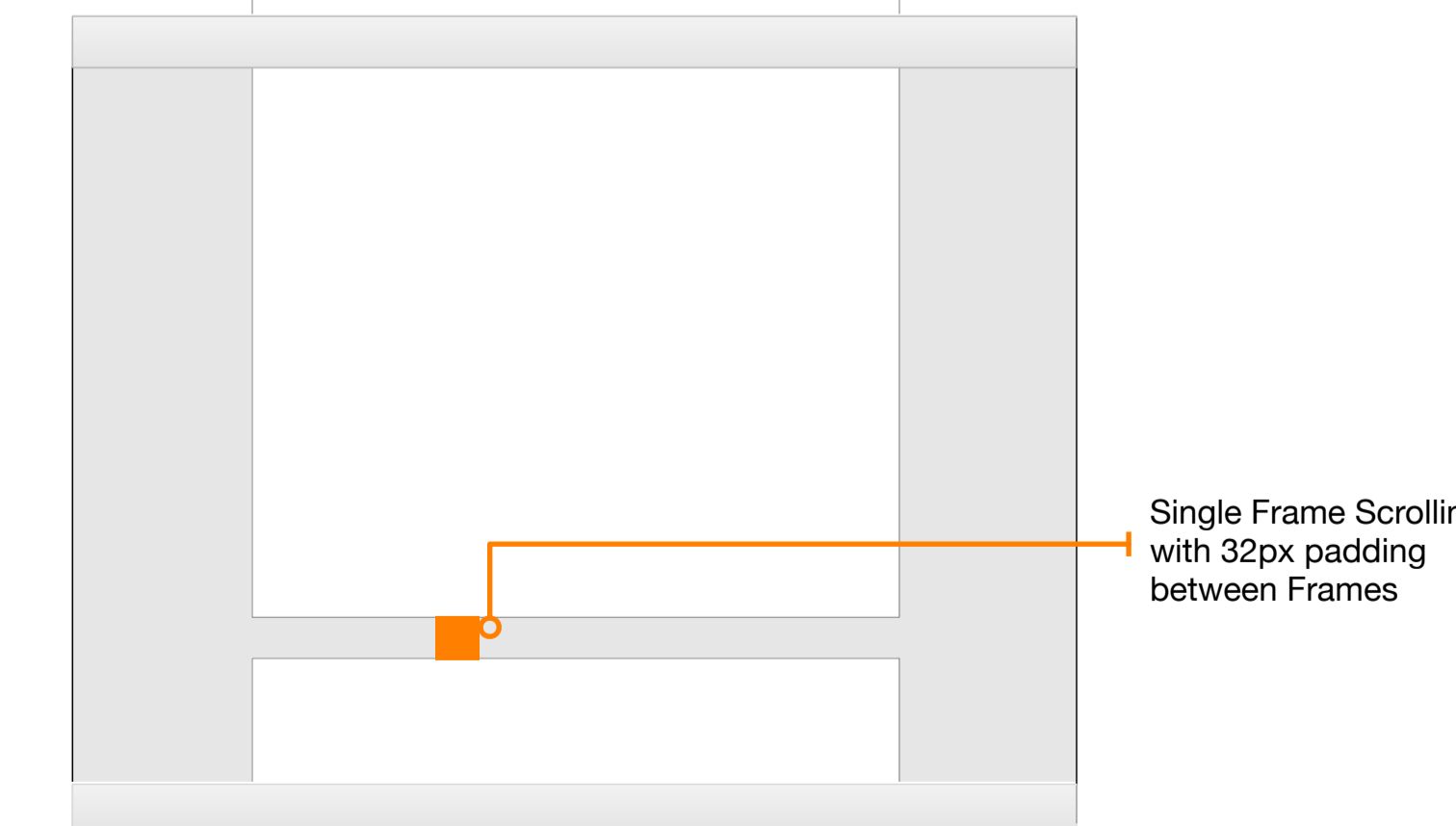


When Focus is on a Frame, The Border Is Thicker

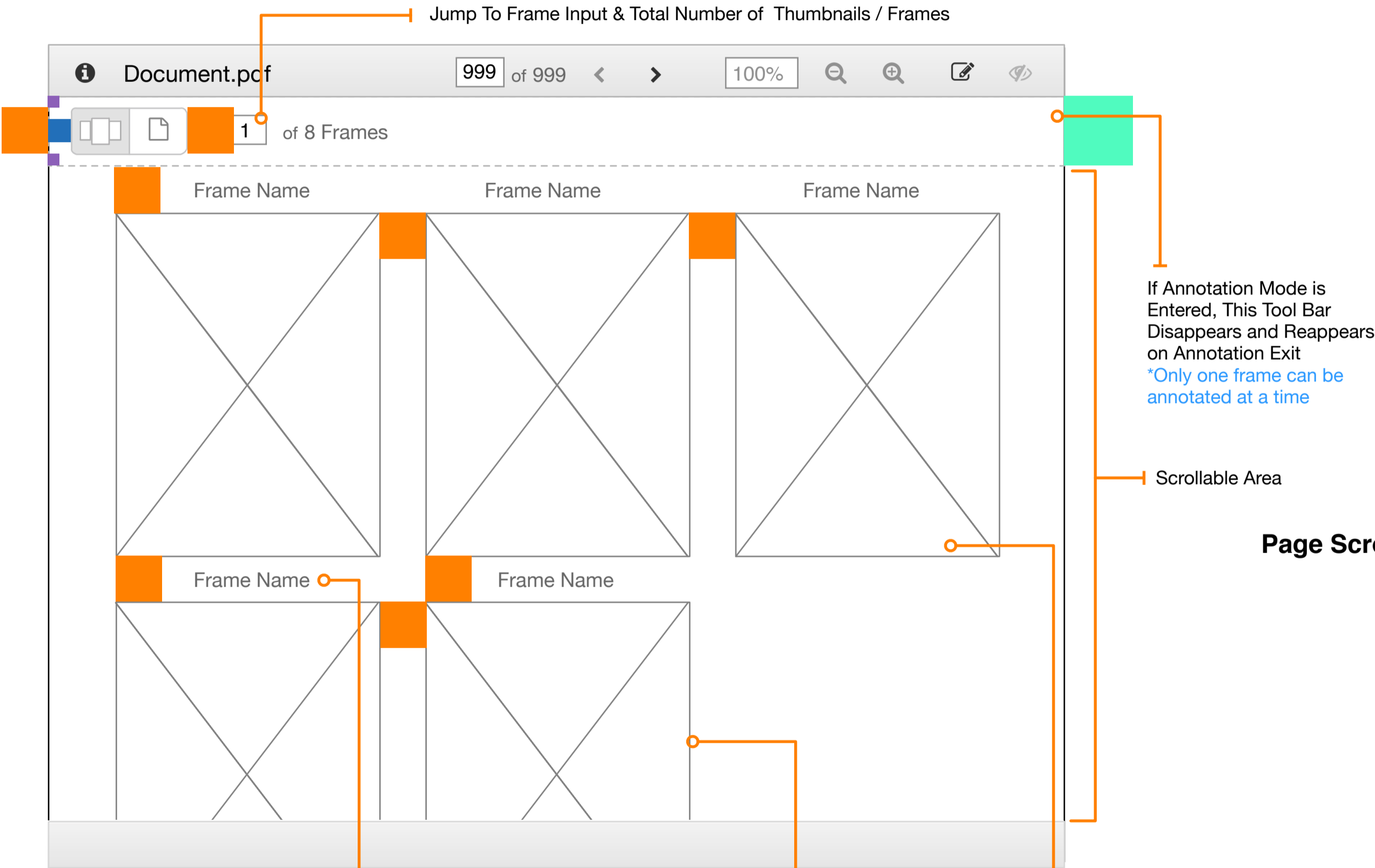
### Page Scroll View

Frame Thumbnails Stay Flush Left

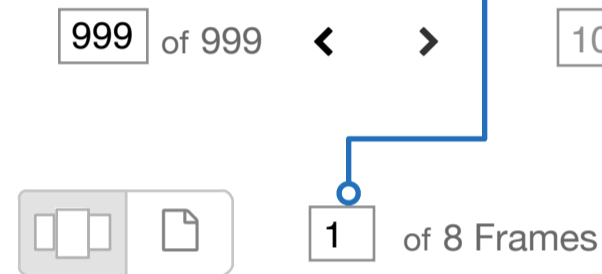
Number of Thumbnail Columns Are Dependent on Width.

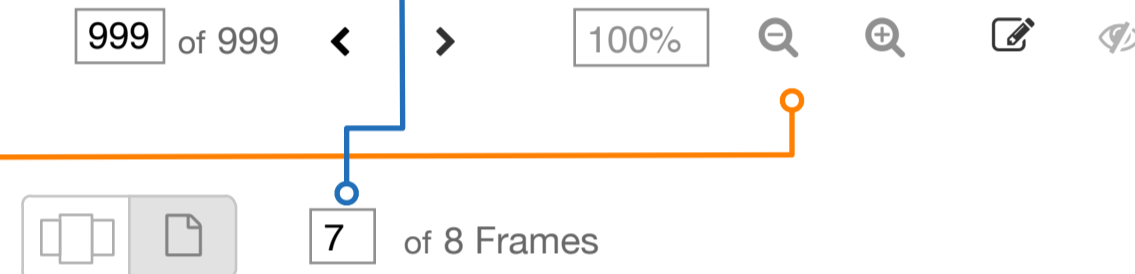
### Entering Annotations Mode

What ever number is in the Frame Input Field becomes the Frame they are annotating

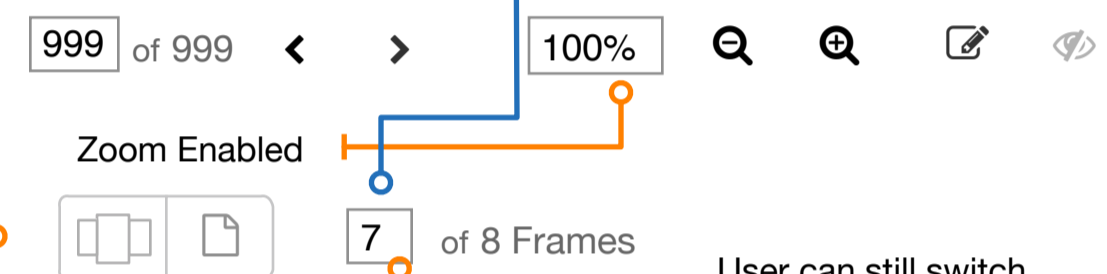

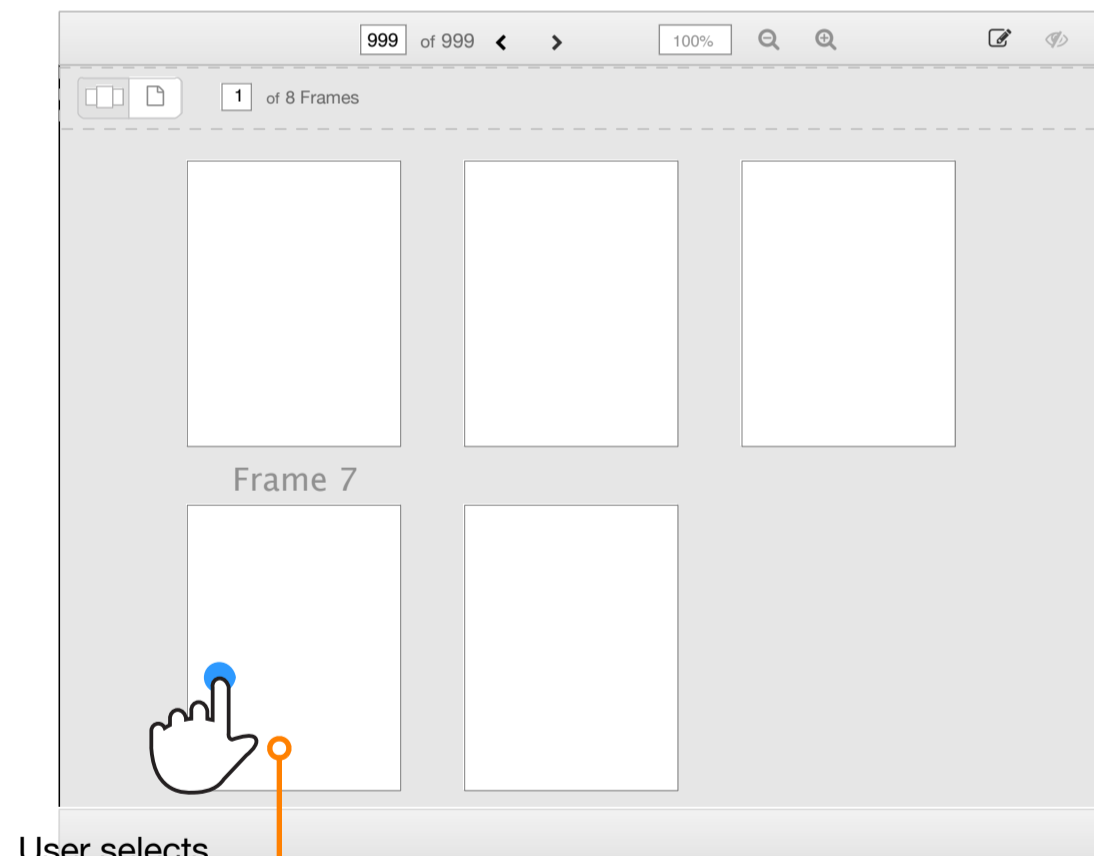


Zoom Disabled in Thumbnail and Scroll View Modes

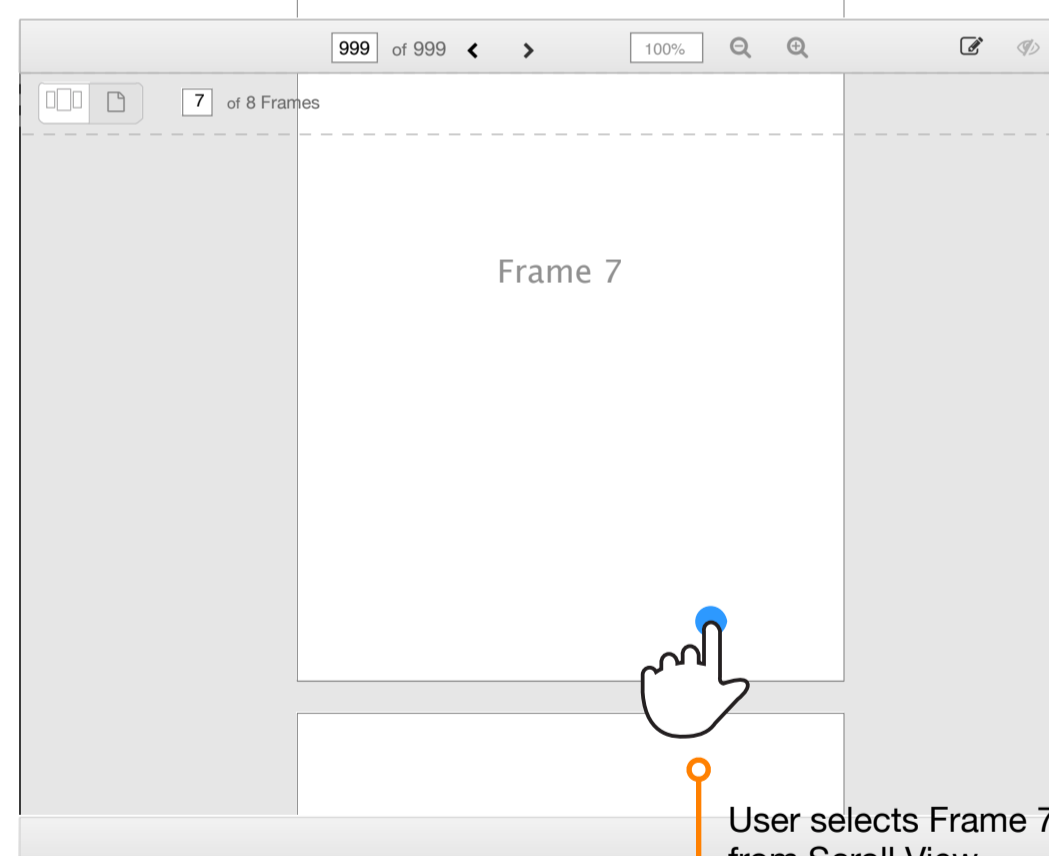

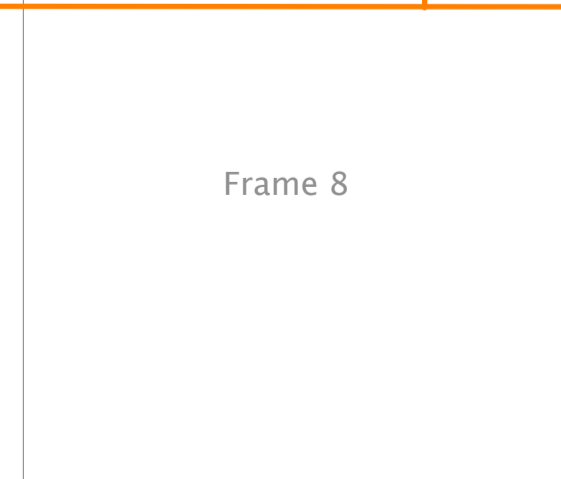

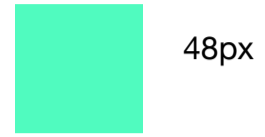


User selects Frame 7 from Thumbnail View

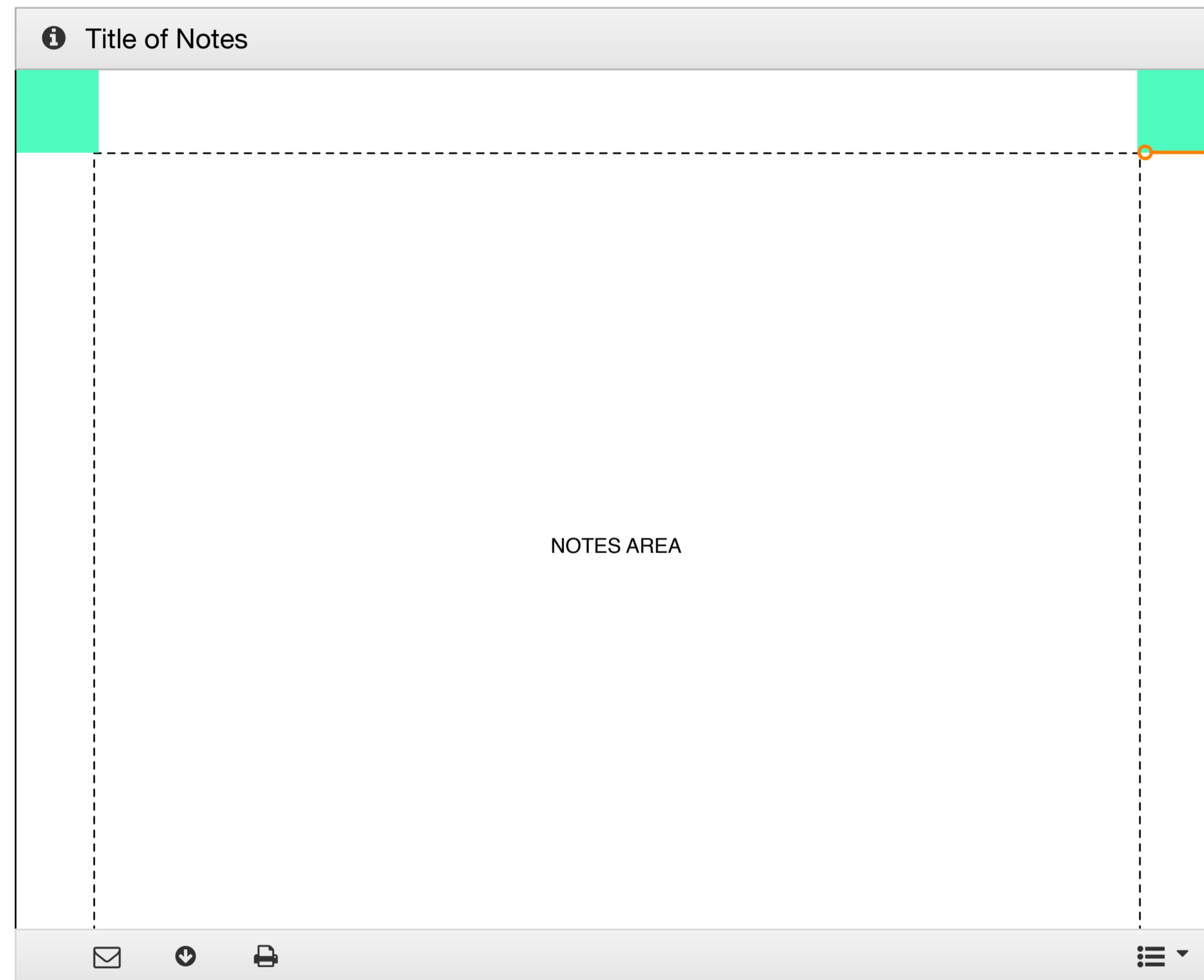
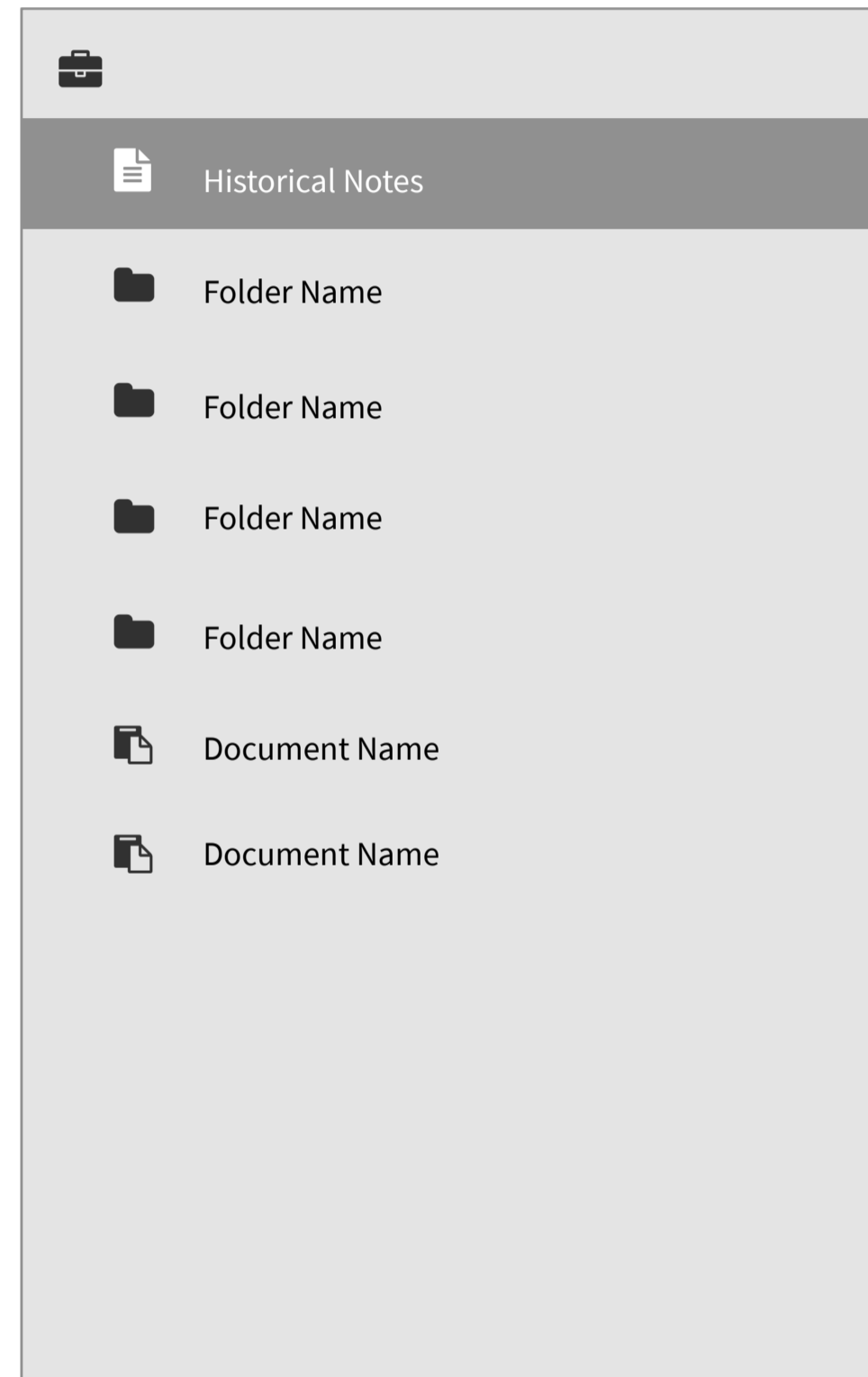
